Solutions

- A: Is this Jessica's jacket that's hanging on the chair?

B: Yes, it's **hers**. She left it there earlier.
- A: **Whose** book is that on the table?

B: I'm not sure. It isn't **mine**.
- A: This is your pen and this is his pen.

= This is your pen and this is **his**.
- A: Are these laptops available for anyone to use?

B: No, they're **ours**. We're using them for the project.
- A: I found some notes in the conference room. Who do they belong to?

B: They must be **theirs**. They had a meeting there earlier.
- A: Someone left a scarf in my car. Do you know **whose** it is?

B: I think it's **theirs**. I saw them wearing it yesterday.
- A: Do you think our group project is better or their group project?

= Do you think our group project is better or **theirs**?
- A: **Whose** idea was it to start the community garden?

B: It was **ours**. We planned it together last summer.
- A: My ice cream flavor was cookies and your ice cream was pistachio.

= My ice cream flavor was cookies and **yours** was pistachio.
- A: Her trip was in Germany and my trip was in New Zealand.

= Her trip was in Germany and **mine** was in New Zealand.
